Main Chances Fund (two funding rounds each year)



- Tertiary studies – including University, TAFE & Apprenticeships associated costs.
- Integration Aide Support
- Sport and music (applicant must demonstrate high level of achievement and that the area of interest is being considered as a career path)

Keeping Kids at Secondary School Fund (Open all year round – Years 11 & 12 only)

- Text books/Stationery
- Curriculum Fees
- Curriculum related Equipment/materials
- Curriculum based camps & excursions



Connecting Kids with Community Fund (Open all year round where funding permits)

- Promoting extra curriculum activities i.e. scouts & guides, club sports
- Equipment/materials (e.g. footwear, uniforms, essential equipment)
- Tuition fees
- Membership fees/Club Insurance & registration fees
