'Child Abuse' includes: sexual offences; grooming; physical violence; serious emotional or psychological harm; serious neglect; and family violence, or exposure to family violence.

If you have any concern that a child may be experiencing any form of abuse, whether or not you have formed a belief on reasonable grounds that the abuse has occurred, you should immediately raise your concerns with one of our Child Protection Officers all can be contacted at the College 03 5021 2911 or by the email addresses below.

The welfare and best interests of the child are paramount. Whenever there are concerns that a child is in immediate danger the Police should be called on 000.
