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Program Details

Allows students to develop their creative and practical skills within a real salon setting.

The program is very hands-on and focused on developing employability skills.

Learn how to prepare clients for salon services, safe use of hairdressing tools and equipment, hair styling techniques and products, all whilst gaining knowledge of the hairdressing industry.

This program is delivered one day per week at Riverside Trade Training Centre through an auspice arrangement.

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Program Content

Techniques & practical skills that students learn include:

- Cleaning work areas and sanitising instruments
- Providing advice on hair care and hairstyles
- Colouring and straightening hair
- Organising appointments
- Greeting and preparing the clients when they arrive
- Shampooing hair and conditioning scalps
- Providing head and neck massages to clients
- Blow drying hair to style and shape and braiding hair into fashionable designs



Structured Workplace Learning

Mandatory

Structured workplace learning complements the training undertaken during class time. It provides the context for:

- Enhanced skill development
- Practical application of industry knowledge
- Assessment of units of competency/modules as determined by the RTO
- Increased employment opportunities.



Contribution to VCE & VCAL

VCE

Students will receive four VCE VET units at 1 – 2 level

VCAL

Contribution to VCAL is determined by the number of units of competence successfully completed.

When a student has been assessed as competent in units totalling 90 nominal hours, this will contribute one VCAL unit towards satisfactory completion of VCAL.

Students can receive up to 4 VCAL credits for VET Salon Assistant.

This program will satisfy learning outcomes for the Industry Specific Skills and Work Related Skills strands of VCAL.

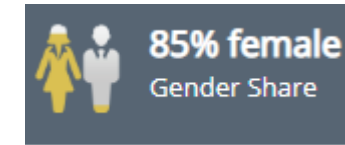
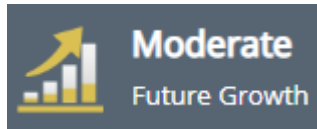

Job Outlook in Australia



PROFILE: In Sunraysia there are many employment options in this industry. Local employers include Hairdressing Salons, self-employment or owning a mobile salon business. There are also opportunities for hairdressers in the television, film and theatre industry, fashion industry and for special occasions such as weddings, debutant balls and working alongside photographers.

OUTLOOK: The number of people working as Hairdressers (in their main job) grew very strongly over the past 5 years and is expected to grow over the next 5 years: from 66,700 in 2018 to 68,900 by 2023.

SKILLS & TRAINING: An apprenticeship in hairdressing is needed to work as a Hairdresser.

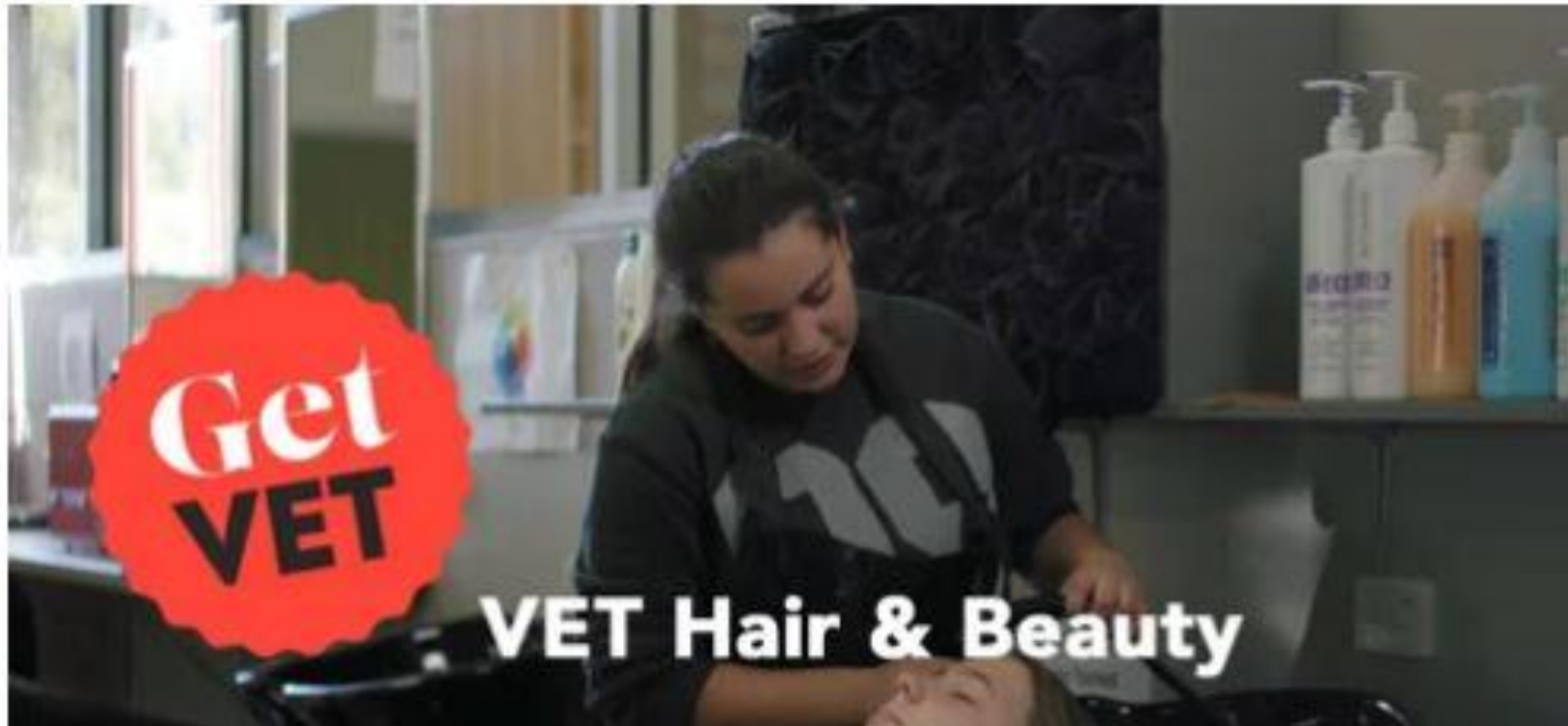

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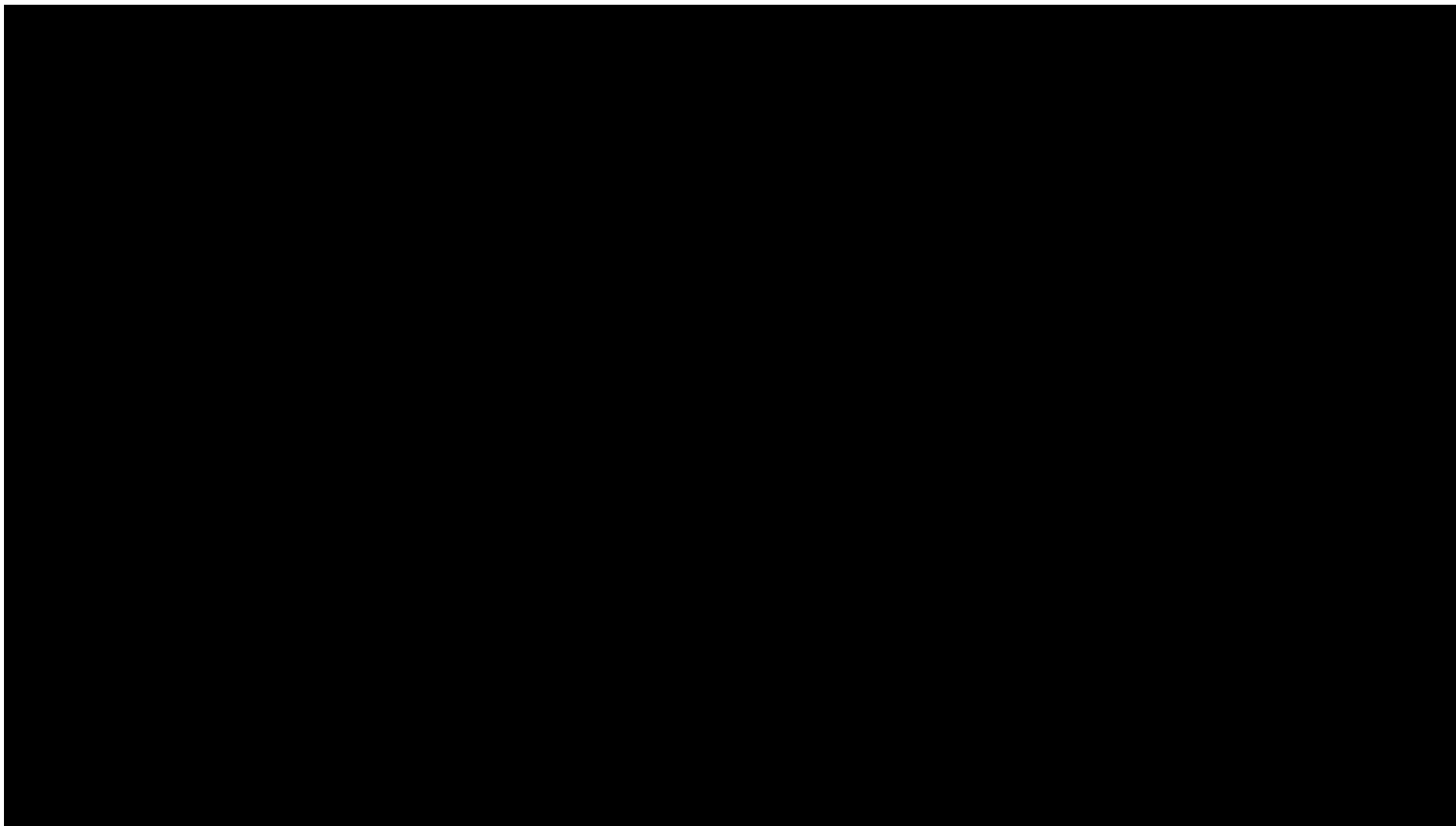
