

ENROLMENT AT MILDURA SENIOR COLLEGE

Mildura Senior College welcomes Enrolments from Year 11 and 12 students living in the Sunraysia District. We offer a large range of subject choices to students to prepare them for their future Pathway and areas of interest. Mildura Senior College offers 44 VCE subjects, 17 VET subjects and a full VCAL program on site. Partnering with local providers, MSC is also able to offer additional VET subjects and Tertiary studies. A comprehensive list of subjects available for student selection is listed on Page 12. Further information on each subject is available via our College website and in the Mildura Senior College Course Selection Guide. Subject offerings are based on student subject selection in the relevant year.

FOR STUDENTS FROM PARTNERSHIP COLLEGES

Mildura Senior College has six partnership Colleges, Chaffey Secondary College, Henderson College, Irymple Secondary College, Merbein P-10 College, Mildura Christian College and Trinity Lutheran College. Students from these schools will have their enrolment coordinated by their Year 10 schools.

COUNSELLING AND SUBJECT SELECTION

This process begins in the 7-10 Colleges from **Monday 3rd August 2020**.

VCAL Expression of Interest Forms are due at Mildura Senior College by **Friday 21st August 2020**. This is a requirement for a student to be considered for VCAL enrolment.

Preliminary choices are due at Mildura Senior College by **Friday 21st August 2020**.

Mildura Senior College staff will assist in course counselling.

FOR STUDENTS FROM NON-PARTNERSHIP COLLEGES

Students from non-partnership schools are required to follow the process below.

How to enrol:

Contact the College on 03 5021 2911 to make an appointment for an enrolment interview or register at the beginning of Term 3. You will then need to collect an enrolment application pack from the front office. Please complete this before your interview.

What to Bring to your interview:

- Most recent reports from current/previous school showing academic achievement, behaviour and attendance records.
- Any certificates (e.g. from TAFE) that the student has completed.
- Formal identification such as Birth Certificate or Learners Permit etc.
- Non-Australian residents must bring their VISA and Passport.
- USI number – obtain from usi.gov.au – see page 37.

NOTE: Enrolment requests will not be processed until such documentation is provided. The College may also request information from your current/previous school.

When to enrol:

The College accepts the majority of its enrolments from August to November for the following year. Requests for mid-year enrolment will take place in early June.

FOR ALL STUDENTS

- The College makes every effort to ensure each student receives the subjects they request. However, factors such as timetable blocks, class sizes and teacher and room availability can restrict subject availability.
- It is preferred that students do not enrol after week three of a semester. However, they could do so to prepare for the following semester.
- Students applying to select a Unit 3 and 4 (Year 12) subject without having completed a Unit 1 and 2 will need to complete and submit the 'Accelerated Studies Expression of Interest Form' available from their home school.

ACCELERATED STUDIES - YEAR 10 STUDENTS

Mildura Senior College offers the opportunity for highly capable Year 10 students to undertake a Year 11 subject of interest as a Year 10 student.

Students must have an outstanding work ethic, and be currently excelling in their Year 9 subjects. The subject chosen should be an extension to what the student is currently undertaking in Year 10 (where possible).

- Students must have been recommended and approved by their home school, as this arrangement can be quite disruptive to their Year 10 program. Students need to complete the 'Accelerated Studies Expression of Interest Form' available from our partner schools. All applications must be made through the current partnership school.

Students will have the opportunity to provide preferences and will only be able to undertake one subject if spaces are available in the course. Students will be notified of this in December via their home school.

ORIENTATION PROGRAM

The purpose of the orientation program is to support the transition of students to the College. We encourage all students to attend this program. The orientation program for Year 11 students will run from 9:00am to 3:05pm from Tuesday 8th to Thursday 10th December.

The program for these days includes:

- Introduction to the Mildura Senior College environment and programs.
- Students will get the opportunity to attend lessons in each of their Year 11 subjects.
- Students can request a subject change at the end of Thursday.

* Year 11 students undertaking a Year 12 subject in 2021 will also need to attend some of the Head Start days (see below) from Monday 16th to Thursday 19th November. Students will be notified of the day/s to attend the week prior.

HEAD START DAYS

Monday 16th, Tuesday 17th, Wednesday 18th and Thursday 19th November 2020. On these days, all 2021 Year 12 students are required to attend as teachers will begin Unit 3 work and give out important work to be completed by the start of the following year. Year 11 students undertaking a Year 12 subject in 2021 will also need to attend Head Start Days. Students will be notified of the day/s to attend the week prior.
