

Debutante Balls

The Mildura Senior College Deb Balls are held in August and are a highlight of the College's calendar year. The main purpose of the Ball is for students, family and friends to come together and enjoy themselves at a formal function.

The Balls are the culmination of several weeks of practise and provide an opportunity for students to participate in a night of formal dancing and the 'introduction' of Debutantes and their partners to an audience of family and friends where they then perform a number of dances. There is also one dance with a 'special person', either a parent/guardian, relative or a close friend. The dances are set to modern contemporary music. Following the official presentation, Debutantes, partners, and their family and friends are free to enjoy themselves and dance the night away. The ticket price includes a three-course dinner, hors d'oeuvres, main meal, dessert, tea & coffee provided by the friendly and professional staff of Club DaVinci. It also includes entertainment by a DJ and staff. The night for guests begins at 7.00pm and concludes at approximately 11.30pm.

When considering participation in Deb Balls, it is important that Debs and their partners be committed to attending all dance practises to ensure confidence on the night. The dance lessons are great fun and a great way to get to know the other people involved in your Deb ball. As with any College function, normal school rules apply and participation must not affect academic progress.

REGISTERING YOUR INTEREST

Debutantes must be students of the College. It is also strongly recommended that partners be current students. The Ball Coordinator and the College must approve partners who do not attend the College. The **maximum number of Debs per ball is set at 15 couples. We also promote an inclusive participation policy.** Students who wish to participate in the Deb Balls are invited to register their interest for the 2023 Deb Balls via Compass at the beginning of the College year. Students must also attend the Information Night that is held in February (*attendance at this night is essential to fully understand the expectations for participation in the Balls*). Due to the popularity of the Deb Balls, places usually fill fast. After indication of interest and attendance at the information night, formal registration begins. Places in the Balls are given in order of registration and payment of the registration fee. The registration cost in 2022 was \$200.00 per person (\$400.00 per couple, *subject to change*). This cost is inclusive of dance lessons, Ball ticket, light meal on the night, posies/buttonholes, Blu-ray/DVD, group photos, official program etc.
