

# Learning Assistance – Homework Club

Homework club is held in the library three afternoons a week where staff will be available to assist students who need help. Other students may simply require a quiet, welcoming environment in which to complete outstanding or future tasks:

- 2:20pm – 5.30pm Monday & Tuesday
- 3:10pm – 5:30pm Wednesdays
- Be organised and use course outlines to know when assessment tasks are happening
- Attend assessment preparation and revision classes

If you are overwhelmed **DO NOT** avoid classes, see your Sub-School Leader for advice.

## WAYS TO HELP YOURSELF

- If you need help, do not hesitate to ask for it.
- Start by asking your classroom teacher.
- Your Pathways teacher is also there to assist your learning progress.
- Look at your Student Learning Progress statements to gauge how you are going.
- Make use of your textbook and Google Classroom resources to improve understanding.
- Keep up to date with classwork and homework.
- Ensure you have a quiet area with a desk at home.
- Complete a homework and study timetable and try to stick to it.
- Do not procrastinate.
- Come in Wednesday morning 9am until 10.30am to get extra help for your subject/s.
- Form a study group to help each other.
- Attend homework club classes Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday after school.
