At Mildura Senior College, the academic / vocational focus of the school and the absence of younger students (most students are 16 to 18 years old) means that school organisation can be approached in ways that may not otherwise be possible. As a result, the College environment reflects a transition from the more closely controlled environment of the junior years to the more self-disciplined environment of the adult world of study or work. This is a learning environment for young people that provides **support** combined with **opportunities to exercise growing independence and self-discipline**.
